Mechanical Engineering Seminar

All graduate students must register for the Mechanical Engineering Seminar each semester.

Minimum Course Load

Any student supported by the Department/University as a teaching or research assistant must register for at least 9 credit hours of graduate-level coursework (courses numbered 5000 and above). International students must register for at least 9 credit hours each semester (excluding summer) to satisfy the requirements of their student visa. Students should contact the International Center before enrolling for less than 9 credit hours

Courses Requiring Instructor Approval

The following courses require instructor approval prior to registration and must be requested during the academic advisement period: Directed Individual Study (DIS), Supervised Research (SR), Thesis, and Dissertation.

Registering for Undergraduate Coursework

Graduate students may register for undergraduate coursework **ONLY** with the approval of their faculty advisor **AND** the Graduate Coordinator. The course must be substantially related to the student's degree program.

Final Term Registration

All graduate students are required to register for thesis or dissertation credit hours in their final term, even if they have satisfied the thesis or dissertation credit requirement for their degree. BS-MS and MS Non-Thesis students are exempt from this requirement.
